Your Walk with Jesus into Freedom – Level 1

Your new beginning

The first disobedience to God started in the garden

God created Adam and Eve, the first man and woman, and placed them in the Garden of Eden. They lived in perfect fellowship with God who provided for all their needs as they obeyed Him.

Then Satan, a fallen angel, came to Eve in the form of a snake. He deceived her in three ways.

First Satan, as the snake, placed **doubt** in her mind by questioning what God had told her.

*Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “**Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden’?**”* Genesis 3:1 NKJV

Secondly he **lies** to her about what God told her to do.

*Then the serpent said to the woman, “**You will not surely die.**”* Genesis 3:4 NKJV

And thirdly he then lies again saying that God has withheld the truth from them and appeals to her pride to be *like* God.

*For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and **you will be like God, knowing good and evil.**”* Genesis 3:5 NKJV

Eve and Adam then acted upon these lies from the Devil and broke God’s law by eating the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. This was the first act of disobedience to the will and ways of God. This is called sin, which literally means to ‘fall short of the mark.’

*So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, **she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.*** Genesis 3:6 NKJV

Satan, the devil used his lies and the evil spirits of doubt, insecurity and pride to cause Adam and Eve to break God’s laws, to sin, and break their perfect fellowship relationship with Him. Satan has continued to use his lies to keep mankind in slavery to sin, rebellion to God’s laws and separated from God.

Jesus came to pay the high price for our sin, and make a way for us to return back to a loving relationship with God the Father.

God the creator of law and order

God is sovereign, meaning that He is in control over all His creation. He created the universe and keeps it in perfect order and balance by His power and laws. He cannot allow sinful, rebellious

people to live in His perfect heaven and Kingdom of God or it would no longer be perfect and holy.

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1 NKJV

God said, ...*“Be holy, for I am holy.”* 1 Peter 1:6 NKJV

We must understand that living in freedom requires responsibility to obey the laws of God.

Just imagine the danger of giving someone a driver’s license who does not know and obey the laws of the road. This is similar to the requirements to live in peace in the Kingdom of God. We must faithfully obey God’s law to maintain safety, peace and love for all those who dwell in His kingdom, in His Holy Presence.

We were all born into slavery

The Bible tells us, “... *all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,*” Romans 3:23 NKJV

Jesus said, “...*Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.*” John 8:34 NKJV

Good News - Jesus came to set us free

Jesus, the Son of God, came down from His throne in heaven to earth to set us free from slavery to our sin!

Jesus took all our sin, iniquity, rebellion, lawlessness, falling short of the target upon Himself on the cross, so that we could be forgiven of our sin and be reconciled back into a right relationship with God the Father.

Jesus paid a debt that He did not owe for our great debt that we could never pay. Jesus, by His death on the cross, became a perfect sacrifice for us, and took our sins upon Himself. This made a way for us to be reconciled back into an everlasting loving fellowship with God the Father.

*The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold! **The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!**”* John 1:29 NKJV

Isaiah 61:1 NIV ***The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners***

Jesus gave us a way to return into the family of God. *But **as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:*** John 1:12 NKJV

Jesus came to set us free! Praise God!

Jesus set us free from captivity to sin, condemnation and everlasting torment in hell.

We can know the truth. The truth is the man, Jesus, the Son of God. *Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. John 14:6 NKJV*

"And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:32 NKJV

"Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed." John 8:36 NKJV

How do we receive this great gift of freedom?

What is required of us to receive such a great free gift of forgiveness, freedom from our slavery to sin, salvation and a new everlasting life in loving relationship with God?

The Bible teaches us, *that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.* Romans 10:9 NKJV

The Bible teaches us that, *...by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.* Ephesians 2:8-9 NKJV

We must turn away from our sin and return back to the Lord. Then by the power of the Spirit of God working in us we can start our new life of freedom from sin and condemnation, by living for Jesus in His way and will and not in our old selfish worldly ways.

Jesus also came to bless mankind with the grace and truth of God. *For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.* John 1:17 NKJV

The grace of God is the power of the Spirit of God working in us so we can live up to the high standard of obedience that God requires for us to be members of His family and citizens of His Kingdom of God.

The sacrificial blood of Jesus washes us clean of our sin

The Bible calls us to live in the Spirit and apart from sin: *"Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires."* Galatians 5:24 NASB This is so God can grow the fruits of the Spirit in us.

We have to spend time with God removing the sin that robs our joy, steals our blessings, damages our relationships and breaks our fellowship with God. First identify the sin and then be encouraged to agree with God, confess, repent, and turn away from them by the grace of God and the power of the Holy Spirit living in you. **Then be set free from sin and walk in freedom.**

1 John 1:9 NKJV *If you confess your sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

Romans 5:1 *Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,*

Romans 8:1 NKJV *There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.*

Warning if you fall away again

If we continue to live in sin and rebellion to the ways of God after you have learned the truth, then we are giving the great work of Jesus on the cross no value.

Please be warned never to turn away from your faith and trust in Jesus who died for you.

*“Once people have seen the light, gotten a taste of heaven and been part of the work of the Holy Spirit, once they’ve personally experienced the sheer goodness of God’s Word and the powers breaking in on us—if then they turn their backs on it, washing their hands of the whole thing, well, they can’t start over as if nothing happened. **That’s impossible.** Why, they’ve re-crucified Jesus!” Hebrews 6:4-6 The Message*

Jesus can not be crucified again.

If you know the truth and then fall away, then you are worse than in the beginning before you knew.

Choose wisely

You have two important choices. You must choose to be a slave to sin or be a slave to righteousness.

*Do you not know that to whom you **present yourselves slaves to obey**, you are that one’s slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of **obedience leading to righteousness?***

Romans 6:16 NKJV

As a follower of Christ, you enjoy freedom and slavery at the same time. Freedom in Christ does not mean freedom from obligation and the hard work of obedience to the will and ways of God. We do not have a license to do whatever we wish. True followers of Christ enjoy the freedom from slavery to sin and its consequences. We are free to obey God and be enslaved to God to serve Him and love Him. Followers of Christ find their joy in freedom from sin and being slaves to the righteousness our Master, Jesus Christ.

God wants us to be enslaved only to Him, and to no one or nothing else. Are you enslaved to something other than God? Like debt, food, another person, entertainment, spending, an addiction?

The Bible tells us to turn to freedom in Christ

*They promise them freedom, while they themselves are slaves of depravity—for **a man is a slave to whatever has mastered him.** 2 Peter 2:19 NIV*

We must choose to turn away from our sin, rebellion to God and lawlessness and return to the ways and will of God. Turn away from besetting sin. These are sins that we accept in our lives.

The thief comes to kill steal and destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. John 10:10 NKJV

This day and every day choose abundant life in Christ and not death and destruction.

Always remember that, your choices affect not only you, but also your spouse, your family and those around you. You must consciously and actively chose life and obedience to the ways and will of God, so that you can be blessed and be a good witness to the saving, redemptive and transforming power of Jesus working in and through you.

Walk in freedom, power, light, life and love so others can follow Jesus and do the same.

Always remember that judgment and hell are very real. All of your choices have everlasting consequences not only for you, but also your family, friends and those around you for the generations that follow.

Take control of your thoughts

The grace of God and the power of the Holy Spirit working in you gives you the power to take control of your thoughts, by turning from evil and turning to the truth of God.

casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, 2 Corinthians 10:5 NKJV

Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. Colossians 3:2 NKJV

Obey the Lord and be blessed

We express our love and devotion to the Lord by obeying Him, and as we obey Him we open the way for God to bless us.

*Whoever has **my commands and obeys them**, he is the one who **loves me**. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him." John 14:21 NIV*

Experience the superior pleasures of God

This fallen world is full of sinful counterfeit pleasures that seem enjoyable for a time, but end in death and everlasting separation from the love of God. God offers us His true superior pleasures to enjoy forever.

... "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." 1 Corinthians 2:9 NKJV

The Lord has so, so much more to share with you.

NOW chose to confess your sins to God. Agree with Him that you have sinned and rebelled against Him. God hates sin and you also must hate sin. Chose the righteous and obedient way to live in truth, light, love and freedom.

4. **Love God with all your *strength*** – You love God with the natural resources that He has given to you to manage. You love God with your time, money, energy, talents, words, works and influence. We turn the use of these resources toward the work of God and growing His kingdom and away from our own personal comfort and honor.

The purpose of an Ambassador of Christ

An **ambassador** is appointed to favorably represent another government.

An ambassador is a very high calling. An ambassador of Christ represents the King and His Kingdom government on earth. He is called to declare and manifest the Kingdom of God's rule and reign on earth. He hears the Lord, King Jesus, serving Him in obedience and love as He prepares the government of God and prepares the bride to meet our Bridegroom King.

The ambassador is *in* the foreign land and under this present government, but is not *of* this fallen world. An ambassador of Christ represents a superior, supernatural, everlasting Kingdom of God.

The life and calling of the Apostle Paul

Paul was first trained as a Pharisee, a Jewish religious leader who persecuted Christians.

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Paul was traveling to Damascus to persecute ‘followers of The Way’, Christian’s, and he had a dramatic divine encounter with the Lord on the road.

*Acts 9:3-6 NKJV As he journeyed he came near Damascus, and suddenly **a light shone around him from heaven.** ⁴ Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, “Saul, Saul, **why are you persecuting Me?**” ⁵ And he said, “**Who are You, Lord?**” Then the Lord said, “I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is hard for you to kick against the goads.”*

What is a Bondservant?

A **bondservant**: *Doulos* in the Greek: is one bound to service without wages like a slave.

This is how the Bible tells us that one became a bondservant to his master.

Exodus 21:1-6 NKJV *"Now these are the judgments which you shall set before them: "If you buy a Hebrew servant, he shall serve six years; and in the seventh **he shall go out free** and pay nothing. "If he comes in by himself, he shall go out by himself; if he comes in married, then his wife shall go out with him. "If his master has given him a wife, and she has borne him sons or daughters, the wife and her children shall be her master's, and he shall go out by himself. "But if **the servant plainly says, 'I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,'** "then his master shall bring him to **the judges**. He shall also bring him to the door, or to the doorpost, and his master shall pierce his ear with an awl; and **he shall serve him forever.**"*

Becoming a bondservant is a serious decision, a choice for life. The judges, in verse 6, were present to witness the servant's willingness to become a bondservant to his master, his willingness to freely give up his freedom for life, and to work for the master and to do his will.

Actually in the Bible a bondservant is one who is set free from slavery, however, they freely chooses to serve their master for the rest of their lives out of their love and devotion to him.

Jesus showed us how He became a bondservant to His Father

*Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself. He had equal status with God but didn't think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages of that status no matter what. Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and **took on the status of a slave**, became human! Having become human, he stayed human. It was an incredibly humbling process. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life and then died a selfless, obedient death—and the worst kind of death at that—a crucifixion. Philippians 2:5-8 MSG*

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Jesus freely chose to humble Himself, leave heaven and come to earth, and live in the limitations of a real man to reveal the heart of God His Father to mankind.

Servants obey the Master

God set His laws in place for us, to bless us for our good. God wants us to obey Him, to be a servant, a bondservant, to Him. He is our Master, we are His servants. He wants this for us, because it is the best way that He can lead us and richly bless us.

*“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but **he who does the will of My Father** in heaven. 23 And then I will declare to them, ‘**I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!**’ Matthew 7:21, 23 NKJV*

2. Is your name written in the Lambs Book of Life?

*But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but **only those who are written in the Lamb’s Book of Life.**” Revelation 21:27*

3. Did you learn to whole heartedly love the Lord?

*And you shall love the **LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.**’ This is the first commandment. Mark 12:30 NKJV*

4. Did you learn to love others?

*And the second, like it, is this: ‘You shall **love your neighbor as yourself.**’ There is no other commandment greater than these.” Mark 12:31 NKJV*

5. Did you follow My commandments?

*“If you love Me, **keep My commandments.** John 14:15 NKJV*

6. Did you confess and turn away from your sin?

*“**If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**” John 1:9 NKJV*

7. Did you forgive others?

“For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ¹⁵ But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. Matthew 6:14-15 NKJV

8. What did you do with what I gave you to steward? Where you faithful?

*His lord said to him, ‘**Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.**’ Matthew 25:21 NKJV*

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9. Did you freely give what you freely received from Me?

*Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. **Freely you have received, freely give.** Matthew 10:8 NKJV*

10. Did you make any disciples as I told you?

***Go therefore and make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen. Matthew 28:19-20 NKJV*

11. Did you share your witness to others about Me, and invite them to follow Me?

*But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and **you shall be witnesses to Me** in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” Acts 1:8 NKJV*

Are you prepared to meet Jesus?

Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to give you an evaluation of your life so far while you still have time to make changes.

Ask, ‘Am I living my life for myself or for the Lord and everlasting value and significance?’

Ask the Lord to *surprise* you and judge you now before it is too late to repent and change.

When you meet Jesus face to face as Judge it will be too late to make any changes in your life.

You will be judged by your works

You are saved by the grace of God. This is a free gift to you that He paid for in full. However, your redeemed life is judged by your works.

Jesus told the seven churches, “*I know your works...*” Revelations 2:2, 9, 13, 19; 3:1, 8, 15

Jesus is always our example.

He came to earth to do the will of His Father in heaven and finish His **work**.

Jesus said to them, “My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. John 4:34 NKJV

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The Lord prepared works in advance for you.

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10 NKJV

The Lord does not want people to work *for* Him. He wants to *partner* with us and work *through* us. This is so we do not work out of our pride and for our own honor, but so that Jesus will receive all the honor and glory that He richly deserves.

All your work in this life will be *tested by fire* , to receive a *reward* and some will suffer *loss*.

*According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But let each one take heed how he builds on it. ¹¹ For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is **Jesus Christ**. ¹² Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³ each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the **fire will test each one's work**, of what sort it is. ¹⁴ **If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward.** ¹⁵ **If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.** 1 Corinthians 3:10-15 NKJV*

*But do you want to know, O foolish man, that **faith without works is dead**?* James 2:20 NKJV

What are the works of God?

Righteousness and justice are the foundations of the throne of God.

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Mercy and truth go before Your face. Psalm 89:14 NKJV

These works of God include: Loving God, obeying His commandments, loving others, teaching and caring for your family, neighbors, the poor, widows, orphans, and freeing the oppressed.

Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' Matthew 25:45 NKJV

We offer spiritual sacrifices of our lives, love, obedience, repentance, righteousness, holiness, humility, prayers, praises and thanksgiving

1 Peter 2:5 'you also, as **living stones**, are being built up a **spiritual house**, a **holy priesthood**, to offer up **spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.**'
