Lord, I repent for and renounce everything that has allowed the enemy to steal my prayers.

I repent for and renounce all ungodliness ever uttered from my mouth in prayer or otherwise according to Isaiah 32:6-7. I repent for the destruction of my neighbor (Proverbs 11:9) through controlling witchcraft prayers birthed out of fear instead of faith. Lord, help me to not be overcome with evil but to overcome evil with good according to Romans 12:21. Please restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit to sustain me (Psalm 51:12) so that I may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Romans 15:13)

Lord, please forgive me for misunderstanding the high calling and privilege of intercession (1 Samuel 12:23). I repent for myself and those in my generational line who left their watch and station, whose hearts were not perfect towards you as your eyes went to and fro the earth searching (2 Chronicles 16:9) and who did not understand or seek you (Psalm 53:2).

I choose now to be stationed on the rampart, to wait upon You (Psalm 130:5) and to hear what You will say to me. Lord, I choose to write down all the words that you have spoken to me according to Jeremiah 30:2 so the future generations will understand your vision and can run with it. I choose Your timing, for You have appointed a time for everything (Eccl 3:1)

I repent for not trusting in You with all of my heart and for leaning on my own understanding (Proverbs 3:5). I repent for praying my will instead of Your will (Matthew 6:10). I renounce and repent for not relying on Your Word and for not trusting that it is profitable for doctrine, reproof, correction, instruction, and equipping according to 2 Timothy 3:16-17. I repent that from my mouth has come both blessing and cursing (James 3:10), and that I have allowed corrupting talk to come out of my mouth (Ephesians 4:9).

I repent for not seeking first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness (Matthew 6:33) and instead seeking and praying for my own will and desires. I repent for and renounce not believing that all things are possible with You and through You (Luke 1:37). Forgive me for limiting You and for allowing doubt to control me.

I repent for and renounce not receiving Your dreams and praying them into reality because they are so big. Please release the gift of faith and expectancy in me, so that I will know with confidence that as I call on You, You will show me things I knowest not (Jeremiah 33:3)

Lord, I repent for and renounce not acknowledging You in all my ways so that You may direct my path (Proverbs 3:6). I repent for not knowing You and for not praying what is on Your heart. Lord, I desire to know You and to pray what is on Your heart and to receive Your blessings.

I repent for not committing all my ways to You (Psalm 37:5), not seeking Your will in all I do (Proverbs 3:6), and for trying to establish my own steps (Proverbs 16:9) fighting battles You never told me to fight. I repent for the presumptive prayers and presumptive battles I fought in my own strength and with my own strategies; fighting them in ways You did not give me.

I repent for and renounce looking at my own circumstances and praying from a soulish perspective and a worldly view. I repent for not having learned to be content with whatever the circumstances (Phil. 4:11). I repent for trusting in man and for making flesh my strength (Jeremiah 17:5), for trusting in chariots because there are many (Isaiah 31:1), and in systems and governments that are made up of mere humans who have but a breath in their nostrils (Isaiah 2:22).

I repent for and renounce praying prayers of doubt, unbelief, self-righteousness, pride, jealousy, envy, fear, hard-heartedness, strife, selfish ambition, judgement, and deception. Lord, please remove all bitter root judgements that I have agreed with. Please remove all ungodly intercession based on these sins. I choose to walk in power, love, and a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7).

I repent and renounce, all jealousy, envy, and attempting to steal the giftings and callings of others. I repent for not living a life worthy of the calling I have received (Ephesians 4:1) and shutting the door on the children of God so that they would forfeit their callings. I repent for not being humble and gentle and for not being patient and bearing with one another in love (Ephesians 4:2)

Lord, I admit these things have interfered with my intimacy with You and my intercession for others. I choose to completely forgive those who have been jealous of me or tried to steal my giftings of callings or who have tried to steal my birthright or interfere with my intimacy with You and my intercession for others. Lord, I now choose to freely give what You have given to me according to Matthew 10:8 so that You may rebuke the thief in my life and in the lives of others. I choose to lay down my life so that you may raise it up again.

I repent for and renounce everything that I have said, prayed, or done from selfish ambition and vain conceit (Philippians 2:3) Forgive me for praying manipulative prayers out of a selfish motive for the purpose of controlling others for selfish advantage. Father, please remove and cancel the effects of all the soulish prayers, ungodly intercession, prophesies, and declarations that have released curses against me, my family, and others. I forgive those who have knowingly or unknowingly brought curses upon my family by praying their will instead of Yours.

I repent for and renounce praying striving, compulsive prayers from a state of anxiousness and unrest instead of praying from a state of rest by being seated with You in the heavenly places according to Ephesians 2:6. Lord, I choose to have my eyes focused on the King's face where there is light and favor.

I repent for those who rejected the identity of sonship with You and rejected the spirit of adoption and walked according to the futility of their minds. Lord, according to Romans 8:15, I receive the spirit of adoption whereby I cry "Abba, Father". I choose to walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7) and I come into agreement with the truth that as Your child I have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus (Hebrews 10:19).

I repent for and renounce taking the yoke of religious, organizational, and manmade intercession instead of taking on Your burden of intercession. Thank you that your yoke is easy, and Your burden is light according to Matthew 11:30. I ask You to break off all ungodly yokes and false burdens of intercession from me and my family line. I break all agreements made to ungodly religious and governmental authorities.

Lord, please break off of me and my family the consequences of fatherlessness, as You are a father to the fatherless (Psalm 68:5), abandonment, as nothing can separate us from God's love (Romans 8:38), rejection, as You are able to save us from the uttermost (Hebrews 7:25), and the consequences of allowing a false spirit of Elijah to have power over my intercession and prayers.

I repent for all ungodly intercession directed to idols, gods, goddesses, objects, heavenly and earthly objects, and the dead. Forgive me, Lord, for putting my trust in any other god (Exodus 20:3) Father, please break off the consequences of ungodly intercession that hindered Your answers to prayer from Your throne.

I repent for and renounce trusting in manmade formulas, and for trusting in mortal man, in whom there is no salvation (Psalm 146:3). Lord, I repent for not surrendering to the Holy Spirit, allowing Him to make intercession through me according to His mind and the will of God. (Romans 8:26)

I repent for and renounce all ungodly chanting, ritualistic, and repetitive prayers that You warn us against in Matthew 6:7. Please remove the curses that were activated and the ungodly forces that were empowered by these unrighteous prayers and thought processes.

Father, please remove from my heart, mind, and will all deception and wrongful motivations and intents that would cause me to pray misguided prayers.

I repent for not honoring the godly men and women who have prayed Your heart, Lord God. Please pour out the godly bowls of intercession prayed by the saints before me.

Lord, I repent for not continuing steadfastly in prayer (Colossians 4:2), for not pursuing and travailing as Elijah did 1Kings18 until Your purposes have been joyously fulfilled, and until heaven gives rain and the earth produces it's fruit. Lord, please establish me as the tree planted by the water that spreads out her roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes, but it's leaf will be green, and not anxious in the year of drought, nor will it cease to bear fruit (Jeremiah 17:8)

I repent for and renounce praying faithless prayers and not having faith for you to heal the sick. Lord, I desire to please You by praying in faith as You instruct us in James 5:15. I believe You are good and I believe James 1:7 that every good gift and every perfect gift is from above and comes down from the Father of lights.

I repent for and renounce listening to or using flattery, as it is liken to a net that spreads over my neighbor for him to step into according to Proverbs 29:5. I repent for causing destruction and ruin and for misrepresenting God's truth in order to control others for my personal gain.

Lord, I repent for and renounce any coming to the altar of incense before being cleansed and confessing sins, faults, and offenses to one another.

I repent for not seeking You earnestly and with my whole heart (Psalm 63:1 and Psalm 119:2), taking delight in You (Psalm 37:4), and seeking Your face always (Psalm 105:4). I repent for doing as I pleased on the day of prayer and fasting. I repent for believing the outward works of fasting and prayer would bring results when we inwardly held on to strife and dissension that resulted in the cursing and exploitation of Your children.

Lord, I choose the fast You have chosen according to Isaiah 58:6-11, loosing the chains of injustice, breaking the yokes of the oppressed, feeding the hungry, providing for the homeless, and clothing the naked. I choose to do right, to seek justice, encourage the oppressed, defend the cause of the fatherless, and plead the case of the widow.

{WOMEN}

I repent for times I took it upon myself to act Holy Spirit to the men in my life. I repent for the times I did not allow men to be the spiritual leader in my marriage but instead tried to take on that position.

{MEN}

I repent for all inconsideration, for all dishonoring, and for not recognizing my wife as a joint heir by the grace of God. I repent for not loving my wife as Christ loved the Church and gave Himself up for her (Ephesians 5:25). I choose to live in consideration of my spouse and honor her as a joint heir of God's grace. I repent because of fear and passivity, and the times I relinquished my responsibilities as the leader of my home.

{EVERYONE}

I repent for not know or did not care to knowing my responsibility for intercession. I repent for not valuing intercession, for times I said it was for others, and did not pray. Father, forgive me for prayerlessness.

Lord, I choose to enter into Your gates with thanksgiving and your courts with praise to give thanks to You and to bless Your holy name (Psalm 100:4)

I repent for and renounce being narrowminded and not embracing all the body of Christ who may see things differently than I do. Forgive me for only recognizing in word and not deed that Your body, just as the human body, is made up of many parts but all are members of that one body, being many, are one body, as is Christ (1 Cor 12:12). I repent for a narrow view of Your Kingdom. I ask You to remove all the limitations that I have agreed with and replace them with Your understanding, Your wisdom, Your knowledge, and the fullness of who You are. I repent for using liberty as a cloak for cursing and speaking evil in my prayers against other believers. I lay down my need to be "right" and exchange it for Your love for the body of Christ. I will learn to walk in a culture of honor.

I repent for not praying for leaders and those in authority as You commanded us in 1 Timothy 2:2 so that we may lead quiet and peaceable lives. I repent for and renounce not submitting to governmental authority; I also repent for and renounce cursing those who rule over us (Exodus 22:28) and praying against the President and other governmental officials as they have been appointed by God (Romans 13). I repent for not honoring the leaders of my nation and for not praying for and seeking peace in my city, state, and nation where You have cause me to live.

I repent for letting false prophets, diviners, and the news media deceive me and cause me to bring negative prayers to You. I repent for following men, even good men, rather than looking to You for direction. I repent for not seeking divine insight.

I renounce generational terrorism, treason, insurrection, and murder. Lord, please remove all judgments that I have brought against myself, my family, and Your people through unrighteous prayers.

I repent for and renounce believing and trusting in lying words that cannot profit (Jeremiah 7:8), walking in discouragement, pain, suffering, disappointment, hopelessness, and allowing these circumstances to negatively affect my intercession.

I repent for and renounce being ignorant of the righteousness of God, and for seeking to establish my own, not submitting to the righteousness of God (Romans 10:3), praying prayers to look or sound righteous as the Pharisees in Luke 18:9 did, rather than praying in humility and coming into Your presence and communing with You, Lord.

I repent for prolonged kneeling, self-abasement, flagellation, and striving in prayer, and for going beyond the leading of Your Holy Spirit so that we could boast of our prayers. Forgive me for boasting in anything but the Lord (2 Corinthians 10:17)

I repent for and renounce praying and bowing the knee to any man, angel, idol, or image rather than to You, Lord God. I repent for not relying on You to strengthen my feeble knees.

I repent for confused, faithless, and complaining prayers during a time when You were chastening me. I repent for not believing that You chasten the ones You love according to Hebrews 12:6. I acknowledge that Your desire was to strengthen my feeble knees, but my attitude and prayers hindered me from receiving Your correction. Lord, forgive me for not exalting You in prayer as the Lord to whom every knee shall bow. I repent for not strengthening the weak hands and feeble knees of others and for not striving for full restoration, encouraging one another, being of one mind and living in peace (2 Cor 13:11).

I repent for and renounce praying out of a place of disunity with Your body, when I know Your heart is for unity according to 1 Corinthians 1:10 and for praying out of a heart filled with selfish desires, envy, and jealousy. This has caused me to miss the mark. Forgive me for every time that I have pulled off course, either by the enemy or my own unyielding will.

Forgive me for wanting to promote my own self will rather than You. I repent for trying to steal Your glory as I know You give Your glory to no other, nor Your praise to carved idols (Isaiah 42:8 and 48:11) I repent for and renounce idolatry. I choose to set my face like flint, knowing I will not be put to shame (Isaiah 50:7)

Lord, release Your sound as a war cry in me and others that we may worship You with one accord with Your Spirit in such a way that will breach the walls, break through the brass heaven (Deut 28:23), till the earth of iron, and pierce the canopy that holds back the blessings.

Father, in Jesus name, I choose to empty myself of fleshly emotions and desires and ask You, Yahweh, to fill me with Your mind, Your heart, and Your will. Lord, please forgive me for not perceiving who You are and for not approaching You in true intercession that comes from worshipping You in the fullness and totality of who You are.

I repent and renounce for coming into Your presence with sacrifices and offerings that cost me nothing (2 Samuel 24:24). I repent for having an impure heart and filthy hands (Psalm 24:4), for having evil assemblies, pride, and for all rebellion which is as witchcraft (1 Samuel 15:23)

Lord, please remove all ungodly powers, authorities, rulers, elders, and all ungodly spiritual devices that are a consequence of ungodly intercession. I choose to walk in the light as You are in the light (1 John 1:7)

Lord, please break off of me all guilt and condemnation for not correctly interceding, as there is no condemnation in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1). I choose to receive Your forgiveness and to walk in obedience in intercession. I choose to abide in You, Lord ,and for Your Word to abide in me so that I may ask for whatever You place upon my heart in intercession so that it shall be done according to John 15:7

I declare that I will not lean on my own understanding, but in all my ways I will acknowledge You in intercession (Prov 3:5). Lord, I declare that as I sit in the heavenly places with you according to Ephesians 2:6, I will release Your decrees and they shall come into existence on earth as it is in heaven (Matthew 6:10).

Lord, I declare that I will humble myself and allow Your Holy Spirit to teach me all things and to bring to my remembrance all that You have said (John 14:26), I trust in You alone and will rely on Your Holy Spirit to teach me in the very hour what I am to say and what I am to pray (Luke 12:12).
