JESUS

Jesus Christ is the Son of God, Son of Man and Savior of the World and our example for living in a right relationship with our Father in heaven, our Creator.

Christian mean 'little Christ. His followers are being transformed into the image of Christ.

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being **transformed** into the same **image** from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:18

Jesus is the only way to God our Father.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. John 14:6

Jesus did only what His Father showed Him.

Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel. John 5:19-20

Jesus said only what His Father told Him.

I can of Myself do nothing. **As I hear**, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because **I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father** who sent Me. John 5:30

Jesus did only the will of the Father in loving obedience.

... "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done." Luke 22:42

Jesus shows us the will of the Father in His Word.

And the **Word became flesh and dwelt among us**, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of **grace** and **truth**. John 1:14

Jesus brought us His grace and truth.

For the law was given through Moses, but **grace** and **truth came through Jesus Christ**. John 1:17

Jesus gave us the power of the Holy Spirit to be witnesses to Him.

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8

PRAY

The disciples of Jesus asked Him to teach them to pray as He prayed to His Father.

In this manner, therefore, **pray**: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. **Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth** as it is in heaven. Matthew 6:9-10

This makes prayer is the most *powerful* thing you can do, as you partner with God to restore and re-establish His kingdom and His will upon the earth!

Rejoice always, 17 pray without ceasing, 18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

These three verses teach us principles of a Christian lifestyle. The will of God is to thank Him in all things. As we do this all day, every day, we are effectively praying continually. As we pray and thank God, we realize how intimately He is always involved in our lives to bless, protect, provide, lead and guide us. This will cause us to joyful rejoice always. We are to live as Spirit filled, Spirit led and Spirit empowered children of God.

Jesus teaches us to pray to our Father in heaven, in Jesus Name and in the Spirit.

... when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. Matthew 6:6

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. John 14:12-14

You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you. John 15:16

praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit ... Ephesians 6:18a

Be persistent in your prayers.

... men always ought to pray and not lose heart, Luke 18:1

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. Matthew 7:7-8

We have confidence when we pray in the will of God.

Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him. 1 John 5:14-15

History belongs to the intercessors who partner with the Lord!

HEAR

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. John 10:27

God created mankind to have an everlasting loving and growing relationship with them. He does this by talking to us and leading us individually, corporately and nationally.

if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, [repent] then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

The Lord speaks to us primarily through His Word in the Bible.

And the **Word** became **flesh** and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, 2 Timothy 3:16

Learn to *prayer* read the Bible and ask the Holy Spirit, who is the divine Author, to give you wisdom revelation and guidance to understand and obey the Word of God.

do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the **spirit of wisdom** and revelation in the **knowledge of Him**, 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of **His calling**, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is **the exceeding greatness of His power toward us** who believe, according to the working of His mighty power. Ephesians 1:14-19

We need to read and have the Word in us so the Holy Spirit can guide us into all truth.

However, when He, the **Spirit of truth**, has come, **He will guide you into all truth**; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. John 13:16

LOVE

God created us in His image, as members of His family to have an everlasting intimate loving and growing relationship with Him.

For **God so loved** the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be **saved**. John 3:16-17

God is the very definition of true sacrificial love.

Greater love has **no** one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. John 15:13

... God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 8 He who does not love does not know God, for God is love. 1 John 4:7-8

Our relationship with the Father grows as we first learn to love Him wholeheartedly

Jesus said to him, "'You shall **love the Lord** your God with all your **heart**, with all your **soul**, and with all your **mind**.' This is the **first** and **great commandment**. And the second is like it: 'You shall **love your neighbor** as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." Matthew 22:37-40

We love Him because He first loved us. 1 John 4:19

- We love the Lord with our whole hearts as we place our attentions and affections upon Him.
- We love the Lord with our whole soul as we focus on Him with all our minds will and emotions.
- We love the Lord with our whole mind as we continue to gratefully think on all His great blessings and goodness.
- We love the Lord with our whole strength as we serve Him in our works, weakness and fasting.
- We love our neighbors sacrificially through our sincere care and service in the Lord's Name for His glory.

Apostle Paul describes our true biblical unconditional Christian love as never failing

Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never fails. 14:1 Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy. 1 Corinthians 13:4-8; 4:1

We demonstrate that we are disciples of Jesus by the love we have for each other .

A new commandment I give to you, that you **love one another**; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34-35

Jesus, as our High Priest, prayed for us to be united together in glorious love with the One Godhead, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

"I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me. "Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me. And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them." John 17:20-26

Love is God's ultimate weapon to conquer sin, rebellion, evil and restore His kingdom rule upon the earth. This is the battle of the bride, a warfare of Love.

And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:8

But I say to you, **love your enemies**, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, Matthew 5:44

The good news of the gospel may be simply stated:

Jesus died for us, to lovingly give His life to us, so He may live His life through us.

OBEY the LORD

We must first know God. *

this is eternal life, that they may **know You, the only true God**, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. John 17:3

Jesus told us how to follow Him.

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. Matthew 16:24

The Word of God maybe summed up in two words, LOVE and OBEY!

"If you love Me, you will obey My commandments. John 14:15

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.'" Matthew 4:4

So Samuel said: "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams. 1 Samuel 15:22

But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men Acts 5:29

And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him." Acts 5:32

And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him, Hebrews 5:9

Since you have purified your souls in **obeying the truth through the Spirit** in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, 1 Peter 1:22

We show our love for the Lord through our obedience to His commandments. These are the Commandments taught by Jesus to be lovingly obeyed.

- 1. **Repent** From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "**Repent**, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Matthew 4:17; I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish. Luke 13:3
- 2. **Follow Me** Then He said to them, "**Follow Me**, and I will make you fishers of men." Matthew 4:19
- 3. **Rejoice and be Glad** Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. **Rejoice and be** exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. Matthew 5:11-12

- 4. Let you light shine before men Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven. Matthew 5:16
- 5. **Honor the law of God** "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the **law till all is fulfilled.** Matthew 5:17-18
- 6. **Be reconciled** leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. **First** be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversary deliver you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison. Matthew 5:24-25
- 7. **Do not commit adultery** But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to **lust** for her has already committed **adultery** with her in his heart. Matthew 5:28
- 8. **Keep your word** But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one. Matthew 5:37
- 9. **Go the second mile** *If anyone wants to sue you and take away your tunic, let him have your cloak also. And whoever compels you to go one mile, go with him two.* Matthew 5:40-41
- 10. Love your enemies But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, Matthew 5:44
- 11. Be perfect, mature *You, therefore, will be perfect* [growing into spiritual maturity both in mind and character, actively integrating godly values into your daily life], as your heavenly Father is perfect. Matthew 5:48 AMP
- 12. Practice disciplines in secret give, pray, fast Matthew 6:1-18
- 13. Lay up your treasures in heaven "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. Matthew 6:19-21 NKJV
- "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Matthew 24-25
- 14. Seek first the kingdom of God But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Matthew 6:33
- 15. **Do not judge** "Judge not, that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you. Matthew 7:1-2

- 16. Do not cast pearls before swine "Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces. Matthew 7:6
- 17. Ask, seek, knock "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. Matthew 7:7-8
- 18. Do unto others Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets. Matthew 7:12
- 19. Choose the narrow gate and way "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it. Matthew 7:13-14 NIV
- 20. **Beware of false prophets** "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. Matthew 7:15
- 21. **Pray for harvest laborers** Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore **pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers** into His harvest." Matthew 9:37-38
- 22. Be wise as serpents and harmless "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore be wise as serpents and harmless as doves.

 Matthew 10:16
- 23. **Do not fear** And **do not fear** those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. Matthew 10:28
- 24. **Obey God's voice** But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by **every word that proceeds from the mouth of God**.' Matthew 4:4; If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear." Mark 4:23
- 25. Take My yoke Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. Matthew 11:29
- 26. Honor your parents For God commanded, saying, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.' Matthew 15:4
- 27. **Beware of leaven, sin** Then Jesus said to them, "Take heed and **beware of the leaven** of the Pharisees and the Sadducees." Matthew 16:6; How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread?—but to **beware of the leaven** of the Pharisees and Sadducees." Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees. Matthew 11-12

- 28. **Deny yourself, endure and follow Jesus** And He was saying to them all, "If anyone wishes to follow Me [as My disciple], he must deny himself [set aside selfish interests], and take up his cross daily [expressing a willingness to endure whatever may come] and follow Me [believing in Me, conforming to My example in living and, if need be, suffering or perhaps dying because of faith in Me]. Luke 9:23 AMP
- 29. **Despise not little ones** "Take heed that you **do not despise one of these little ones**, for I say to you that in heaven their angels always see the face of My Father who is in heaven. Matthew 18:10
- 30. Go to offenders "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. Matthew 18:15
- 31. Beware covetousness And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses." Luke 12:15
- 32. Forgive offenders And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. Matthew 6:12 "For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. Matthew 6:14-15
- 33. **Honor marriage** So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore **what God has joined together, let not man separate**." Matthew 19:6
- 34. **Be a servant to others** Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave— Matthew 20:26-27
- 35. Be a home of prayer And He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you have made it a 'den of thieves.'" Matthew 21:13
- 36. Ask in faith So Jesus answered and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done. And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive." Matthew 21:21-22; If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. John 15:7
- 37. **Bring in and care for the poor and afflicted** Then He also said to him who invited Him, "When you give a dinner or a supper, do not ask your friends, your brothers, your relatives, nor rich neighbors, lest they also invite you back, and you be repaid. But when you give a feast, **invite the poor,** the maimed, the lame, the blind. And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just." Luke 14:12-14

- 38. **Render to Caesar** Show Me the tax money. "So they brought Him a denarius. And He said to them, "Whose image and inscription is this?" They said to Him, "Caesar's." And He said to them, "**Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's,** and to God the things that are God's." Matthew 22:19-21
- 39. Love the Lord Jesus said to him, "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." Matthew 22:37
- 40. Love your neighbor *The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor As yourself* [that is, unselfishly seek the best or higher good for others].' *The whole Law and the* [writings of the] *Prophets depend on these two commandments.*" Matthew 22:39-40 AMP
- 41. **Await the return of Jesus** *Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.* But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also **be ready, for the Son of Man** is coming at an hour you do not expect. Matthew 24:42-44
- 42. **Take communion, eat and drink** And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take, **eat**; this is My body." Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "**Drink** from it, all of you. Matthew 25:26-27
- 43. Be born again Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' John 3:7
- 44. **Keep My commandments** "If you love Me, keep My commandments. John 14:15
- 45. Watch and pray Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." Matthew 26:41
- 46. **Feed My sheep** He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, "Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You." Jesus said to him, "**Feed My sheep.** John 21:17
- 47. **Baptize My disciples** Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Matthew 28:19
- 48. Receive power from the Holy Spirit to be a witness to Jesus Christ But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8

- 49. Make disciples of all nations Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations [help the people to learn of Me, believe in Me, and obey My words], baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always [remaining with you perpetually—regardless of circumstance, and on every occasion], even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20 AMP
- 50. Preach and teach the gospel of the kingdom to the nations, demonstrate the supernatural power of God And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." Mark 16:15-18
- 51. Be wise and obedient to the teachings of Jesus Christ our Lord "Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock." Matthew 7:24-25

We are invited to come boldly to the Throne of grace to receive His mercy.

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain **mercy** and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:16

Know the Word and obey the Word of God in the Bible.

And the **Word** became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14

You need to have the word within you so that the Lord can draw from His resources to know and obey the truth.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the **truth**, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. John 14:6

the Spirit of **truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor **know**s Him; but you **know** Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. John 14:17

You need to be 'brain washed' by the Spirit and Word of Truth to wash out the lies of this present world system.
